NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the following days: **the 15th, 16th, 17th, 20th, and 21st days of September, 2010** between the hours of **eight o'clock in the forenoon and four o'clock in the afternoon** at the Offices of the **Rural Municipality of Hanover, 28 Westland Drive, PTH No. 52, West of Steinbach.**

I will receive nominations for the offices of:

Reeve - Term November 2010 to November 2014

Councillors - Term November 2010 to November 2014 for Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6

Local Urban Districts - Term November 2010 to November 2014 - Three members for each of the Communities of Blumenort, Mitchell, and Grunthal.

of the aforesaid Rural Municipality of Hanover.

The nomination deadline is the 21st day of September, 2010 at four (4) o'clock in the afternoon. Nominations cannot be accepted after this day.

All nominations shall be made in writing and shall be signed by at least twenty-five voters, or NOT less than 1% of the voters (whichever is the lesser) of the authority or ward (as the case may be), but in all cases by at least two voters. Each nomination shall also be accompanied by the candidate's declaration of qualification.

Nominations may be filed in person at the above location, on the date and hours specified, by an official agent, or by fax. To obtain a nomination paper, and / or candidate's declaration of qualification, contact the Senior Election Official at the telephone number listed below.

Nomination papers not accompanied by the required documents and not properly filed shall be rejected.

NOTICE OF VOTERS LIST / PERSONAL SECURITY PROTECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that a copy of the VOTERS LIST may be revised at:

The Offices of The Rural Municipality of Hanover, 28 Westland Drive, PTH No. 52, West of Steinbach, on the 15th, 16th, 17th, 20th and 21st days of September, 2010 between the hours of eight (8) o'clock in the forenoon and four (4) o'clock in the afternoon.

At this time the Senior Election Official (S.E.O.) will be available to update the voters list by:

- (a) adding the names of electors who are entitled to have their names on the list;
- (b) deleting the names of persons who are not entitled to have their names on the list; and
- (c) making such other correction of errors in the list as are required.

VOTER ELIGIBILITY

A person is eligible to have his or her name added to the Voters List if he or she is:

1. a Canadian citizen and at least 18 years of age on election day; and
2. a resident of The Rural Municipality of Hanover for at least six months prior to election day, OR a registered owner of land in the municipality for at least six months prior to election day.

NON-RESIDENT VOTERS QUALIFIED IN MORE THAN ONE WARD:

In accordance with Section 25(2) of The Municipal Councils and School Boards Elections Act, any non-resident voter who owns property in more than one ward is responsible to notify the Senior Election Official in writing, no later than the 21st day of September, 2010 of the ward in which he/she desires to vote. Failing the foregoing, the voter's name will be placed on the list as the Senior Election Official may select.

APPLICATION FOR PERSONAL SECURITY PROTECTION:

A voter may apply in writing to the Senior Election Official (at the address/fax number below) no later than the 21st day of September, 2010 to have his/her name and other personal information omitted or obscured from the voters list in order to protect the voter's personal security. The application may be submitted in person, by mail or fax and must include your name, address and include proof of identity.

All changes to the voters list may be completed on or before September 21, 2010.
